# Internet Danger Zone

## Protecting Yourself from Identity Theft.



Learn to navigate the Internet Danger Zone safely.

1. Make sure you have up-to-date anti-virus and anti-spyware software installed on your computer. Run a full scan at least weekly.
2. Keep your computer operating system up-to-date, and have your firewall turned on.
3. Use strong passwords on secure sites – at least eight characters combining random letters and numbers. Change passwords regularly.
4. Only download images, movies or songs from trusted sites. These kind of files are easily infected with malicious computer code.
5. Only use password-protected public WiFi hotspots, and don't use your computer for online banking when connected to a public hotspot. Turn-off any auto-connect features. They might cause your computer to log into unsecured wireless networks without your knowledge.
